#### CCF syllabus: courses objectives for 4-year B.A (Major) in Sanskrit

##### **DSCC- 9: PANINIAN GRAMMAR**

**Course objectives:** To acquaint the students with general Sanskrit Grammar.

##### **DSCC-10: INDIAN PHILOSOPHY: GENERAL INTRODUCTION AND SPECIAL ACQUAINTANCE WITH NYAYA VAISESIKA**

**Course Objectives:** This course aims to get the student acquainted with the cardinal principles of the Nyaya – Vaisesika philosophy through the Tarkasamgraha and to enable students to handel philosophical texts in Sanskrit. It also intends to provide them with an understanding of the basics of Indian Philosophy through various Indian philosophical systems.

##### **DSCC-11: VEDIC LITERATURE: SAMHITA AND BRAHMANAS**

**Course Objectives:** This course on Vedic literature aims to introduce various types of vedic texts. The aim of introducing Vedic grammar is to read and understand text correctly.

##### **DSCC-12: Semester- V: INDIAN EPIGRPHY**

**Course Objectives:** This course aims to acquaint the student with the epigraphic journey in Sanskrit, The only source which directly reflects the society, politics, geography and economy of the time. The course also seeks to help students to know the different styles of Sanskrit writing.
